STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING OF RECIPROCITY OR COMITY

between

Georgia Board of Registration for Professional Geologists

and

Mississippi State Board of Registered Professional Geologists

The Boards of Registration for Geologists of Georgia and Mississippi hereby enter into a common understanding concerning registration of Registered Professional Geologists by reciprocity or comity, subject to the provisions listed below:

- 1) Any written Association of State Boards of Geology (ASBOG) examination administered by either Board shall be accepted by the other in considering applicants for registration by reciprocity.
- Either Board may require an additional examination related specifically to the practice of 2) professional geology in that state.
- 3) Evidence of a valid certificate of registration from one of the states is required for registration by reciprocity in the other. The candidate requesting reciprocity must be in good standing with the state in which that person holds their current registration as a registered professional geologist.
- 4) Applicants for registration by reciprocity that were registered under the grandfather provisions of the state in which they currently hold registration may be exempted from a written examination upon verification of at least five (5) years of responsible professional work experience since the date of their registration.
